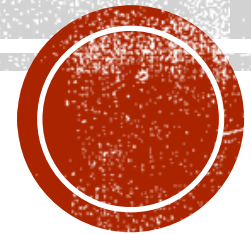

# WHAT IT IS

- Equality means **being equal in all aspects such as status**, rights irrespective of caste, color, race, gender, etc...
- Anti-racism is a process of actively identifying and opposing racism. The goal of anti-racism is to challenge racism and actively change the policies, behaviors, and beliefs that perpetuate racist ideas and actions.



# SOME KINDS OF EQUALITY

- Legal equality = Legal equality or equality before law

is fundamental to legal justice. Legal equality implies that all are alike in the eye of law and that are entitled to its equal protection. The rich and poor, the high and low should all be treated alike.

- Political equality= is the quality of a society whose members are of equal standing in terms of political power or influence. ... Equal citizenship constitutes the core of political egalitarianism. This is expressed in such principles as one-person/one-vote, equality before the law, and equal rights of free speech.



# ANTI-RACISM

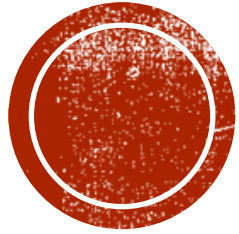
People often mistakenly believe that simply being "not racist" is enough to eliminate racial discrimination.

The problem with this perspective is that White people are often unaware of their own unconscious biases. Research has found that people who believe that they are not racist are often much more prejudiced than they think they are.

People often don't even notice how policies, institutions, and systems disproportionately favor some while disadvantaging others.

This includes our schools, the justice system, the government, and hospitals.
